

NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF BOND RESOLUTION

SUBJECT TO PERMISSIVE REFERENDUM

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Board of Trustees of the Village of West Winfield, Herkimer County, New York (the "Village"), at a meeting held on February 10, 2025, adopted a bond resolution, which is subject to a permissive referendum, that authorizes the purchase of a motor vehicle used for fighting fires, whether or not including apparatus used in connection with such motor vehicle, or the purchase of such apparatus alone, at a maximum estimated cost of \$700,000, and authorizes the issuance of not to exceed \$700,000 serial bonds of the Village to pay the costs thereof. The period of probable usefulness is twenty (20) years and the bonds are payable from amounts to be annually levied on all the taxable real property in the Village. Pursuant to the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act and the regulations promulgated thereunder ("SEQRA"), the Village has determined that the Project is a Type II Action requiring no further action under SEQRA.
